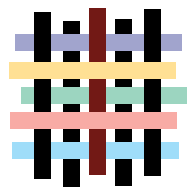

Some requirements that you need to meet

To become a Charter Member you will need to be a U.S. Citizen, 18 years or older, fluent in both your native language and English, and have a strong motivation to help your fellow citizens throughout the nation and world. Males are required to have met their Selective Service obligations.
